

Program Note

"Josem", le jeune orchestre symphonique de l'entre deux mers is een vaste gast op het jaarlijkse festival musicalarue, in het zuidwest Franse dorpje Luxey. Componist Bart Picqueur maakte deze feestelijke muziekdagen enkele malen met het jonge orkest mee en hem gevraagd werd een werk te componeren voor Josem en hun toemalige dirigent Niclas Lescombe was het snel duidelijk dat dit zomerfestival de inspiratiebron zou vormen tot deze kleine zigeunersymfonie. De titels van de afzonderlijke delen verwijzen met een knipoog naar de pastorale symfonie van Ludwig von Beethoven, maar beschrijven (niet verhalend) de sfeer op de artiestenkamping.

Josem, youth orchestra from entre deux mers, near Bordeaux, France is a frequent guest of the annual 'musicalarue' festival in Luxey, southwest of France. Composer Bart Picqueur joined them several times at this occasion, and when their conductor Nicolas Lescombe asked him to compose a new work for the young musicians it was obvious that this festival would be the inspiration to this little gipsy symphony. The subtitles are a wink at Beethoven's 6th, describing the atmosphere at the artist's camping.
